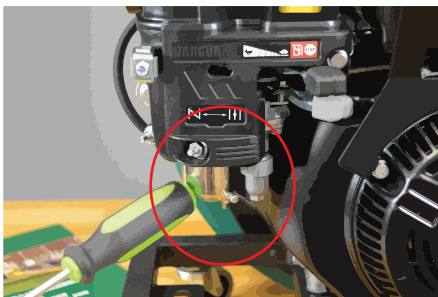
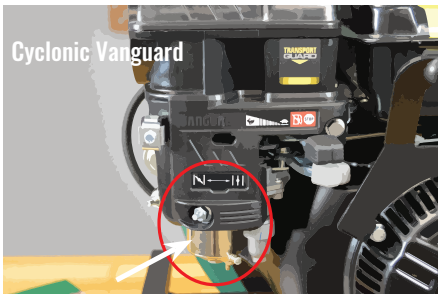
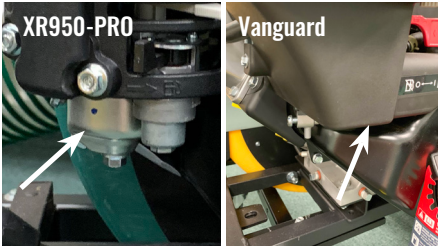


My Engine Will Not Catch/ Will Start and then Stop

1. Dislodging the float valve.

- To dislodge the float valve, find the carburetor. It's located near the metallic fuel bowl underneath the air filter. Give it a nice solid tap with the bottom of a screwdriver or rubber mallet.
- You can even take a couple laps around your property with the engine off.
- If the float valve was lodged this will dislodge it.
