



Replacement Side Tube Assembly & Installation Instructions

Follow the instructions below to assemble the 3 parts of the side tubes and installing them onto the Collector Frame.


TOOLS YOU'LL NEED: (2) 7/16 Wrenches or Sockets




1. Take the straight section of the side tube and locate both swaged ends. Insert one swaged end of the straight section into one of the bent legs.




2. Make sure the snap buttons on the straight section align with the holes on the bent leg. You should hear a "click" sound when the two pieces are connected properly.




3. Next, insert the other swaged end of the straight section into the second bent leg. Again, make sure the snap button and holes are aligned with a "click" sound.




4. Place collector bag in the upright position – with the top brace removed.



5. Open the Velcro strip, or top zipper that secures your collector bag to the top of the side tube.



6. With the side link locked in place, disconnect the pivot bolt and lower the side link out of the way.




7. Disconnect the front and rear hinge bolts from the ends of the aluminum side tube.



- **8.** Slide the side tube out of the collector bag.
- **9.** If replacing both side tubes, repeat steps 5-8 on the opposite side of the bag.




10. To Install the new side tube, start with the collector bag flat on the collector frame.



11. Place the plastic side tube insertion plugs into both ends of the new aluminum side tube.

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12. Slide the side tube into the pockets on the collector bag. Slide the tube evenly for least resistance.



inserted, remove the plugs and secure the upper zipper or Velcro flap. Note: The Velcro strap should completely cover the Velcro strip on the collector bag.


14. If replacing both side tubes, repeat steps 11-13 now.

Bolt Assembly Instructions

Follow the instructions below to reinstall the side tube and side link assemblies. When reassembling the side tubes, it is important that the bolt heads be placed on the inside of the frame (facing the collector bag). This assembly requires nylon lock nuts. Do not substitute ordinary nuts. If your machine is equipped with plastic wear blocks (A), follow the "Style 1" instructions. Otherwise, follow "Style 2".

Install the Side Tube

STYLE 1



15. If your machine is equipped with plastic wear blocks (A), be sure bolts are installed with heads on the inside, facing the collector bag.



16. Bolt heads must sit flush with plastic wear block.

STYLE 2




15. If your machine is not equipped with plastic wear blocks, install bolts with heads on the inside, as shown.




16. Do not over-tighten the bolts. Tube must be free to rotate in the hinge bracket.


Install the Pivot Bolt




17. If your machine is equipped with one or more plastic spacers on the side tubes, install bolts as shown, with the bolt heads on the inside.



18. Finished installation with plastic spacers looks like this.



17. If your machine is not equipped with plastic spacers, install bolts with heads on the inside.



18. Finished installation without plastic spacers looks like this. Do not overtighten bolts. The side link must be free to rotate against the side tubes.

19. If replacing both side tubes, repeat **steps 15 to 18** for the other side tube.
