

## **Collector Bag Repair Kit**

Accidents happen, and you need to repair a hole or tear in your collector bag. This kit will let you fix most of the most common mishaps.

First, identify the type of tear you have:

## For straight cuts or slits up to 18 inches in length the REPAIR TAPE is the way to go

- 1. All repairs are made from the inside of the bag.
- **2.** Wipe off the loose dirt and dust, then use the alcohol wipe to clean the PVC lining for at least two inches on either side of the tear.
- **3.** Cut a piece of the repair tape two inches longer than the tear. Round the corners of the tape section to prevent peeling.
- **4.** Start at one end of the tear and peel the backing as you press the tape over the tear. This works best if you can lay the bag on a flat surface so you can apply pressure as you put down the tape.
- **5.** Allow the tape to cure for 24 hours before using the Cyclone Rake.

## For jagged cuts and holes you'll want to use the FABRIC PATCH

- 1. All repairs are made from the inside of the bag.
- **2.** Cut the fabric to size, overlapping the hole by at least an inch. Round the corners of the patch to prevent peeling.
- **3.** Wipe off the loose dirt and dust, then use the alcohol wipe to clean the PVC lining for at least two inches all around the tear.
- **4.** Cover the entire PVC side of the patch with the flexible adhesive making sure you get right to the edges.
- **5.** Place the patch over the hole and apply pressure. This works best if you can lay the bag on a flat surface so you can press the whole area of the patch.
- **6.** Allow the bond to cure for 24 hours before using the Cyclone Rake.
